The club was established in 1885.

They became members of the top division of the East Anglian League in 1952.

In 1963-64 the club won the league's Knockout Cup, beating Norman Old Boys in the final.

At the end of the season the league merged with the Norfolk & Suffolk League to form the Anglian Combination with Harleston being placed in Section A.

However, they were subsequently relegated over the seasons by several divisions.

In 1980–81 Harleston were Division Three champions.

They went on to win Division Two the following season, earning promotion to Division One.

Following two relegations, in 2005–06 the club finished bottom of Division Three and were relegated to Division Four.

A third-place finish in Division Four in 2008-09 saw them promoted back to Division Three.

The club were champions of Division Three again in 2010-11 before winning the Division Two title in 2011–12.

After finishing as runners-up in Division One in 2013–14, Harleston were promoted to the Premier Division.

They were Premier Division runners-up in 2016–17 and won the division the following season, earning promotion to Division One North of the Eastern Counties League.

Despite finishing as runners-up in Division One North in 2018-19, the club were relegated back to the Anglian Combination Premier Division as their ground failed the grading criteria by not having floodlights.

However, at the end of the 2020-21 season they were promoted back into Division One North of the Eastern Counties League.

The 2021-22 season saw the club enjoy the Thurlow Nunn Division One North campaign finally finishing in second place behind Sheringham.

This meant a play-off position had been achieved, the first Semi-Final of which saw The Magpies take on Framlingham Town and win by 2 goals to on.

The final saw them pit their skills against Downham Town and in a game that at one point was very close they finally went onto to win 3-1 to confirm promotion into the Premier Division and step 5 football for the first time in their history.

During the close season Nicky Howell resigned as manager and the club acted quickly to bring in ex professional Danny Crow as manager for the 2022/23 season

The 2022/23 season once again saw them adapt well to the higher standard finally finishing in 3rd place just outside a play-off place.

Last season they finished 6th just outside the play-off spots, they took part in their first ever F.A. Cup match, losing 3-2 at home to Kempston Rovers and reached the Norfolk Senior Cup guarter-final before losing to Watton United.

This season hopes are high for another push for promotion and a good Cup run.

Match Report v Great Yarmouth Town

Thetford Town: Gilchrist - 60'

The new season was certainly underway, this game coming only three days after Thetford' solid away win at Brantham Athletic.

This games marked Thetford's first home game of the season as they welcome newly promoted Great Yarmouth Town, a team with a strong fan base, a great nickname with 'The Bloaters' and also kicking off the season with a win against Long Melford.

Promoted teams traditionally do well, so this was set to be a big test for a Thetford Town side with ambitions of another promotion push.

It had been a hot summers day in Norfolk, with the evening cooling down nicely for the evening kick-off, to create near-perfect conditions.

Onto the wonderful looking pitch the two teams lined-up, Thetford Town in claret and blue, with Great Yarmouth in their home amber and black colours.

KEY MOMENTS

TT = Thetford Town

GYT = Great Yarmouth Town

- 3' GYT There was an early chance for Great Yarmouth, Duffield fires off a speculative long-range strike, the Thetford keeper spills the ball and Fenn tries the follow-up, but Tom Smith just about gets there first.
- 5' TT A sweeping attack from Thetford, King tries to thread in Mann, the ball is intercepted and falls to Gilchrist who hits the ball first time from 20 yards, and curls it just beyond the top right corner of the goal.
- 16' GYT Great work by Fenn down the left wing, he drives a low hard ball across the box, begging for the tap-in, but somehow evades everyone.
- 18'- TT From the midfield, Olpin fires in a low effort from 25 yards, it is well-struck & heading into the bottom corner, but Ling gets down well to make the stop.
- 24' TT Grove intercepts a defensive pass and bursts forward on goal, he squares to Diggens but the ball is slightly behind, Diggens has to turn on the ball, he then takes a touch and blazes in an effort from just outside the box, the ball crashes into the side netting and it initially looked in, but sadly, the ball had travelled the wrong side of the upright, big let off for The Bloaters.
- 30' GYT Barber intercepts a loose ball and plays Couzens down the right, he takes it forward a couple of strides before finding Duffield, who shimmies into the box and cuts a strike across Tom Smith, but Tom gets down and gets an all important touch on the ball to concede the corner.
- 36'- GYT Great Yarmouth batter the Thetford box, with multiple efforts flying in, the best from Barber which is brilliantly blocked by Elliot Smith, Thetford putting bodies on the line to prevent the opener.
- 38' TT Haylett is fouled on the right just outside the box, the referee waves play-on and King takes the ball into the box skipping past several challenges before being taken out for what looked like a dead-set penalty. Confusingly, the referee went back to the initial foul, so what was the point of playing advantage? Another let off for Great Yarmouth Town and a possible turning point in this tight contest? - 45'+2 GY Sam Adams hits an absolute belter of a strike from 30 yards, forcing Tom Smith to make a diving save on the stretch.
- 45'+4' -GY GOAL (0-1) Moments before the half-time whistle, Great Yarmouth Town snatch a goal, Thetford fail to effectively deal with a corner ball, it falls to Deeks who turns and volleys from inside he box, the ball hit with such venom that Tom Smith had no chance at all. It has to be said that it was a wonderful hit, but a disastrous time to concede for Thetford.
- 54' GY GOAL (0-2) Not long after kick-off to the second half, The Bloaters stretch their lead, the goal coming from yet another poorly defended corner kick, allowing Connor Deeks a free header, and he obliged to absolutely slam the ball home for his second of the night, stunning the home crowd.
- 60' TT GOAL (1-2) Thetford peg one back, a quickly taken free-kick from Haylett finds King who bounds forwards and lays the ball across to Gilchrist, who in a bit of space in a central position has a dig from 20 yards out, absolutely leathering the ball beyond Ling, it crashing into the crossbar, slamming into the ground and back to ripple the top of the net, stunning hit from the Thetford Town favourite.
- 61' TT Thetford nearly equalise moments later, Grove darts down the left and squares the ball into the box, Elliot Smith is on it with a diving header but the connection is not strong enough and the ball is eventually collected by Ling, so close!
- 69' GY Another corner causes chaos in the Thetford box, it is eventually recycled out to Belmar on the right who breezes past Olpin and curls a shot towards goal that forces Tom Smith to beat it away with his fist.
- 72' GY GOAL (1-3) The Thetford defence are under huge pressure and Grove attempts an ill advised cross field clearance, but there is not enough on it, Barber intercepts, strides into the box and his shot slams into the post and out, but Belmar is on-hand to fire home on the follow-up and restore The Bloaters two-goal lead. Great Yarmouth go on to close out the game in an impressive fashion, the defence holding firm.

What started a pretty even and competitive first half ended is a comprehensive defeat for Thetford Town, as newly promoted Great Yarmouth Town made it two-from-two.

The optimist in me sees this as a game of moments that went against Thetford, had the Grove interception gone in, had the penalty been given, had Elliot's diving header gone in etc. it could have been a different game, the penalty decision being the bitterest pill to swallow.

However, the realist saw a largely poor performance from Thetford Town, they looked frail in set-pieces and the attacks fizzled out due to inaccurate passing and making the wrong decisions in the final third. I do think we missed Kieran Money tonight, his link-up between defence and attack is invaluable, as is his work breaking down attacks, but this does not excuse the result.

It does have to be said that Great Yarmouth Town were excellent, they were organised, broke fast, were aggressive in the press and fast to the loose ball, they are clearly still riding the crest of a wave and looked like a well-oiled machine.

Long Melford 0 vs 6 Thetford Town @ Stoneylands Stadium - Long Melford Saturday 17th August 2024 - Thurlow Nunn League Premier Division

Attendance - 68

Thetford Town: King - 39', 46', Haylett - 59, Laker - 73', Mann 76', H. Lott - 86'.

Following Thetford Town's heavy 4-0 midweek away defeat at Soham Town Rangers, they were back on the road again, this time to face Long Melford down in deepest Suffolk. With both teams having a challenging start to the 24/25 season, it was a chance for either team to kick-start their season, but who would be taking the chance?

Long Melford away is one of my favourites, in possibly the most picturesque town in the league, always a pleasure. It was a perfect summer's day at the perfect temperature, with crisp blue skies. The pitch was a little bobbly but overall decent, to which Long Melford lined up in their black and white stripes, with Thetford Town yet again in their claret and blue.

KEY MOMENTS

LM = Long Melford TT = Thetford Town

- 2' LM Early chance for the hosts, a long ball bounces over the backline and Judge latches onto it, from the edge of the area he shoots, but Jaydyn Lott gets across to make an important block.
- 5' TT A through ball puts Diggens through on goal, he is much quicker than the defender and is yanked back in what was a clear professional foul, but inexplicably the referee waves play-on.
- 11' TT A Cameron King corner is driven in low, captain Sam Bond swings his boot and connects well with the ball, it is deflected, flicks up and is heading in, forcing keeper Walker to make a brilliant save, tipping it over for a corner.
- 22' TT Harvey Lott is threaded in, he rides the challenge and finds himself charging through on goal, keeper Walker in out fast and from just outside the box Lott tries to chip the ball over him, but Walker is equal to the effort.
- 35' TT From a Thetford attack, the ball is semi-cleared, but falls to Olpin, he takes a touch and powers in a fine low strike from 20 yards out, it cuts through the crowd and beats Walker, but crashes into the post and out, so unlucky!
- 39' TT GOAL (0-1) A great run from Diggens sees him beat the offside trap, the long ball is volleyed on the bounce from outside the box, it is struck sweetly and whizzes past Walker, absolutely clattering the post, it ricochets out and falls perfectly to King coming in from the right, and he sweeps the ball into the open net, giving Thetford the all important lead, deserved based on the run of the play.
- 43' TT Nearly a quickfire second for Thetford. King chests down the ball and pings it forwards on the volley, the ball is weighted perfectly and Diggens is again through, seeing Walker rushing out he chips him with the outside of his boot like a 5 iron shot, it looks to be looping in, but falls just wide of the mark. It was so close it looked in, causing the fans to initially cheer!
- 46' TT GOAL (0-2) Only 45 seconds into the 2nd half and Cameron King shows why he is such a feared player in this division. He picks up the ball on the left, skins the defender, drives down to the byline, skips down it towards the goal and bends it into the net from a tight angle, frankly ridiculous solo effort, no idea how he got it from that angle! Great start to the half for Thetford. *Cont.*.

Match Report v Long Melford - Continued

- 55' LM A strong Long Melford attack down the left, Judge gets the ball on the edge of the box, steps inside and unleashes a powerful strike at the near post, but Dickerson is equal to it and bats it away for a corner.
- 56' LM The corner ball is swung into the near post and there is contact by a Long Melford player, but a good close range stop from Dickerson prevents the ball from going in.
- 59' TT GOAL (0-3) Thetford received a free-kick in the Long Melford half after another cynical foul, leading to the first yellow of the game. King steps up and a curls a devious ball into the box, it evades absolutely everyone except Haylett who sprints in behind and guides his side-footed volley into the net. Things looking good for Thetford.
- 73'- TT GOAL (0-4) Excellent run by Harvey Lott down the right, he gets round the defender and whips in a perfect cross, the weighting and depth of it puts the keeper in no-mans land and Laker ghosts in from the left and nods into the wide open net, surely sealing the win for Thetford.
- 76' TT GOAL (0-5) Thetford now running rampant. Substitute Reynolds passes to Diggens and follows the ball, sprinting down the left, this drags defenders across opening up the middle for Diggens who obliges, strides forwards and sees the run from Jake Mann, threading him through perfectly, and 1-on-1 with the keeper Jake makes no mistake to sweep the ball past the keeper, brilliant play from Thetford.
- 81' TT Diggens is played in down the right, he takes the ball into the box and fires in at the near post, but it is deflected wide by the outstretched leg of Walker, shame as Diggens really deserving of a goal in this game.
- 86' TT GOAL (0-6) Two substitutes link up brilliantly to bag their 6th of the afternoon. Reynolds pings the ball out to the right, picking up the sprinting Harvey Lott, he is through on goal again, and this time calmly slots it past the keeper, great seeing the youngsters showing what they can do!
- 88' TT Laker played in down the left, he tries to get his second, his shot at the near post saved well by Walker, no seven heaven for Thetford today,

Perfect response from Thetford Town following the lows of Tuesday, a changed formation and line-up working well. A tougher first half saw Thetford go into the break 1-0 up, although there were chances for it to be more, but after King's goal straight after kick-off, Long Melford looked sucker punched and never really got going as Thetford Town romped to victory. THE ECL FROM 1935 to 1948 - THE STRUGGLES TO KEEP GOING

Extracts taken from The Eastern Counties Football League History by Mick Blakeman

There were phenomenal changes during the first few years of the ECL 's life. It began as a competition for 12 of East Anglia's leading amateur clubs, yet within four years it had been affected by a series of major events.

It had.....

Embraced professionals

Seen one founder member join the football league.

Seen two more founders replaced by new professional clubs who immediately joined the Southern League.

Had its existence threatened twice - once by a new league covering a significant part of its area and once by the outbreak of war.

It is a glowing testament to the judgement, management, capabilities and good common sense of its officers that the leaguer was able to survive in such turbulent times.

They were greatly assisted in their battles to establish the league by the handful of founder members who were determined to ensure that their brain-child did not become a victim of its own success.

By 1937, founder members Ipswich Town had joined the Southern League, the ECL's five Essex clubs had all left in an attempt to better themselves and Thetford had found the going too tough and dropped down a level to recuperate.

It would have been understandable if the remaining five founder clubs Yarmouth, Lowestoft, Gorleston, Bury Town and Kings Lynn had concluded that their dream of a high quality competition to serve all of East Anglia was fated not to be and decided instead to return to the Norfolk & Suffolk League.

Had they done so, it is probable that the regions football would have become splintered with the Essex clubs moving into one of the amateur leagues covering the home counties while the more westerly clubs such as Kings Lynn and Newmarket may have settled down into the United Counties League.

As it was, those five founders kept their nerve and the league was ready to welcome back the Essex clubs a year later as well as being able to offer an alternative for those further west.

In view of the seven-year break, it was not surprising that some of the pre-war members did not rejoin the league in 1946 and once again, its future was in the balance.

With just 10 clubs, it became questionable as to whether the ECL could provide its members with sufficient fixtures but once again the league's officers rose to the challenge.

Extensive canvassing persuaded several more clubs to apply for a place and in 1948, six new teams joined the league including most interestingly, the 'A' sides of four of London's biggest football league clubs.

For the ECL, the struggles of the past were over and the league was ready to enter an exciting new era.
